SEARCH AND CALL COMMITTEE – LOCAL PROFILE POSTED ON NATIONAL LISTING

The Search and Call Committee completed the UCC Neillsville Local profile and submitted it to the conference. The profile had been posted on the National Office's employment opportunities website.

A scoring sheet has been developed that will be used by the committee members to screen potential candidates profiles. This tool will allow us to have a standard to determine when a potential candidate should be interviewed. Once a candidate had been identified for an interview they will be contacted to schedule such interview. There will be a set of questions that will be consistently used when conducting interviews. If and when the committee deems a candidate a "good fit" for us, the candidate and Trustees council will discuss terms of the agreement. If the parties reach an agreement the candidate will be invited to give a sermon to the congregation. Following the sermon the congregation will have the opportunity to vote on the candidate.

Please keep the committee and church in your prayers that we may be able to recruit and hire our next settled Pastor to serve UCC Neillsville and the community.



Youth Group Leader Proposal

Our church was blessed with a gift from the Marian and Sam Ray Estate with a designation for youth activities. Some of the monies have been used for camp scholarships. The Leadership Council, based on the visioning sessions and small group conversations regarding youth programing has allocated \$5000 from the Ray fund to hire a leader for a Wednesday after school program. The trial program will run two Wednesdays per month, from December 2022 through March 2023

The program will be designed for 5th-8th grade youth. The leader, along with a small church team, will plan and execute the afterschool program. We are looking first for a leader from our church, and will look to the community if there is not internal interest.

This program of doing "different things in different times" will be designed in an effort to bring positive change to the youth identified. Once the program design is developed, we will need volunteers that could prepare meals, help facilitate the meetings and plan for other activities that the group may do on weekends throughout the year.
