Confirmation and Sunday School <u>Update</u>

As many of you know, in the past couple of months UCC and Calvary Lutheran members have continued discussions on ways our churches can collaborate and work together. As part of this effort UCC Christian Ed committee members, Stephanie Heck, Lacey Erickson, Linda Stalsberg, and Jenna Ziegler met with Calvary Lutheran Christian Education committee members and discussed options to collaborate on confirmation and Sunday school. In the past year, (2022-23 school year) Calvary held Sunday School and Confirmation classes after school on every other Wednesday and experienced increased student and family participation.

It has been agreed, for this school year, UCC will combine the confirmation and Sunday school classes with Calvary. Both groups will meet on every other Wednesday. Class locations will again alternate between Calvary and UCC.

Sunday School for kids in 3K to 6th grade from both churches will meet on Wednesday afternoons from 5:00PM to 5:45PM.

Confirmation classes for kids in 7th and 8th grades will also meet on every other Wednesday, This will now be a two-year curriculum with 8th graders continuing to be confirmed each spring at their respective churches.


